You have been assigned a place in one of our rehearsal studios and are now part of a music community which houses close to 500 musicians.

EKHO EKHO is an association with a democratically elected board, which sets the overall guidelines for the operation, work and purpose of the association. The board can be contacted at any time at bestyrelse@ekhoekho.dk.

EKHO EKHO is an inclusive music community. Any form of violence, racism, transphobic, homophobic and/or sexist behaviour can lead to exclusion from the community.

There is an annual general assembly open to all members.

The office

To take care of operations and administration, the board has hired Thomas Mathiesen as manager. Rikke Aaberg Pedersen is employed as member- & venue manager and fundraiser and Sebastian Vinther Olsen is employed as our in-house sound technician.

Your membership

On the website you can see a list of membership offers, benefits etc. that you can receive as a member of EKHO EKHO.

Payment

All members pay DKK 500/month to have access to a rehearsal studio and to use our facilities.

In January each year all members also pay the annual membership fee of DKK 300. When registering, you pay the annual fee for the current year, regardless of month and date.

Update us

As an EKHO EKHO member, you are obliged to inform the office of any changes in your basic information, e.g., address, e-mail address, telephone number. It is crucial that we can get in touch with you.

Key chip

Your key chip is your personal access to the building and to your rehearsal room. Remember to lock the door when you leave your rehearsal studio, it does not lock by itself. If you lose your key chip, we can provide you with a new one. Contact the office during opening hours. A new key chip costs DKK 300.

Termination of membership

If you wish to terminate your membership of EKHO EKHO you write an e-mail to medlem@ekhoekho.dk. In this e-mail, please state your name and the number of your rehearsal studio.

You have one month's notice until the first of the month. Your termination date will therefore always be the last day of the month following your resignation.

Parking

The entire Refshaleøen is a parking zone administered by APCOA. They are extremely diligent and hand out fines generously. We have set up a parking tablet at the main entrance. You can register parking for 4 hours at a time, and this can be extended again and again. Always enter your phone number – this way you get a receipt for parking on your phone.

If the tablet does not work, you must use a parking app such as Easypark to register for payed parking, to avoid a fine.

It is always your own responsibility that your parking is registered. EKHO EKHO has no influence or means to object to any charges that may be issued in the area.

Electrical room

With your key chip, you can enter our electrical room at the end of the building (towards the bus stop) if you experience power cuts. This applies to rooms 1 to 39. The fuses for rooms 40 to 62 are at the opposite end of the corridors on both floors.

Kloster Moster

Kloster Moster is our in-house venue and production rehearsal studio. The room is 67 square meters and is equipped with a stage, backline, PA, refrigerators, picnic tables etc.

As a member of EKHO EKHO, you can borrow Kloster Moster free of charge once a year for a record release, production rehearsal, video shoot, small concert etc.. If you host an event with an audience, there is a mandatory cleaning fee of DKK 1.000.

If you wish to throw a private party, you can rent the room for a reduced price. See prices on the website.

We regularly host concerts, workshops, talks and much more in Kloster Moster. Join us for these events, meet your fellow musicians and help make EKHO EKHO a vibrant music community.

You are very welcome to suggest events yourself, that you would like to experience and/or be a part of.

EKHO STUDIO

As a member of EKHO EKHO, you can borrow the studio for free. However, you must pay for the technician fee. An 8-hour fee costs DKK 2,500. For additional hours, the price is DKK 400 per hour. Send an email to medlem@ekhoekho.dk for more information.

Guests

You are welcome to invite guests to your rehearsal studio, provided that there is at least one valid member present in the room who is responsible for the guest's behaviour. If the same guest musician visits the venue more than 4 times annually, that person must be registered as a member of EKHO EKHO.

Facilities – remember that you make EKHO EKHO a great place

You will be granted access to a specific rehearsal studio. You have access to the room at all hours. Remember that you share the room with other musicians. Therefore, respect each other and agree on how and when the room is cleaned and how tidy you are.

EKHO EKHO is a music community where musicians can meet. In addition to the kitchens, the entrance area on the ground floor allows for this. The common areas are a shared responsibility. It is not permitted to place things in the hallways and kitchens. Leave the areas as you wish to receive them and clean up after yourself.

Kitchens

There is a kitchen both on the ground floor and on the first floor. They are equipped with a sink, oven and hotplates, which you can use. You can also store kitchen items in the cupboards.

When you use the kitchen, you must clean up afterwards. The table must be wiped, and dishes must be washed. Food scraps and coffee grounds must be put in the bin and not in the sink. It clogs the drain, which creates unpleasant smell throughout the building, and potentially leaves us with an extra bill. If you leave dirty dishes, it will be thrown directly into the bin.

Smoking

Smoking is strictly prohibited in EKHO EKHO. Violation of this may lead to exclusion from the community.

Vending machines

On both floors you will find a vending machine with drinks. You can use coins and MobilePay. We regularly add new drinks, but if you notice something is missing, please let us know.

Recycling

All empty cans and plastic bottles with a deposit mark can be thrown in the deposit boxes. In doing so, you provide a small subsidy to the EKHO EKHO's overall finances. Please do not throw glass bottles in the deposit boxes, because then we have to empty the whole bag and start over!

Ventilation

Due to high requirements for sound insulation, the building is very dense. It is therefore important that the premises are ventilated regularly in order to not damage the building. Please air out as often as possible. Remember, however, that it is not allowed to rehearse with open windows, so open them during your breaks.

Waste

At EKHO EKHO, we follow current regulations for sorting our waste. Please follow the instructions on signs and containers and place your waste in the correct bins.

If you are getting rid of a large piece of furniture, a fridge, etc., you must take it to a recycling station.
